The Following conditions, together with any additions or amendments as published by the Organizing Committee, applies to this Championship.

1. GENERAL

12th Pondok Indah International Junior Golf Championship 2025 will be played at the Pondok Indah Golf Course from 16th December 2025 to 18th December 2025 in accordance with the rules of Golf as approved by The R&A, IGA Hard Card 2025 and the Additional Local Rules as approved by the Organizing Committee.

2. ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to all boys and girls who are 18 years old of age or under on 18th December 2025, with following handicapping divisions:

All entries are subject to the approval of the Organizing Committee (OC) which reserves the right to accept or refuse or have accepted subsequently rejecting any entry without giving reason for its decision.

Entrants must conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status as approved by The R&A & USGA.





3. FORMAT OF PLAY

- 1. The Championship will be played on stroke play format over three rounds of 18 holes.
- 2. The Overall Boy and Girl Champion shall be the player with the lowest gross aggregate score over the three rounds.
- 3. Players will also compete in the respective age groups. See Point 2 above.
- 4. A team Event for Boys and Girls will be held in conjunction with the Championship. It shall be played over three rounds of the Championship. Each team will be represented by two/three players, any combination of Class A and B players. The team total daily scores will be based on the two best scores of the team members of each round. The Winning teams shall be the team with the lowest combined gross scores of the team members for the three rounds.
- 5. In the event of insufficient entries, the Team Event may be canceled.

4. SIZE OF FIELD

- 1. The total field will be limited to a maximum of 120 participants, based on first come first serve basis.
- 2. After 36 holes, the field will be cut to the 78 leading players to meet the final round field of 26 groups. The allotments are as follow:

Boys (A+B) Division: Top 42 players.

Girls (A+B) Division: Top 36 players.

Note: In the case where the number of Girls do not meet the maximum allotted total of 36, then the Boys cut shall be adjusted accordingly.

5. ENTRY

- 1. The entry fee per player:
 - **a.** For Classes A, B, C (Boys or Girls) is US\$ 450 (Foreign Player) or IDR 4,000.000 (Indonesian Player)
 - **b.** Entry Fee includes Caddy Fee for tournament day (16th December 2025 to 18th December 2025)
 - **c.** Caddy Tips are excluded.
 - d. Entry Fee are Non-Refundable after closing date of 24th November 2025
 - **e.** Payment must be submitted after entry approved by committee (see the website). Payment should be made to the following account:

- 2. Entries must be on the Official entry form duly endorsed by the Captain /Secretary Club Association. (If a player has his/her handicap Index maintained at more than one Club, he/she shall play of the lower/lowest Handicap Index).
- 3. Entries must be submitted to the Organizing Committee no later than 24th November 2025

6. CLOSING DATE

The Closing date is 20th October 2025. Late entries may be accepted at the sole discretion of the OC.

7. DRAW

- 1. The order of play for the first and second rounds will be made by the OC prior to the Championship.
- 2. The draw for the final round will be based on the cumulative gross of the preceding rounds.

8. TIME OF STARTING

- 1. Players shall start at the time and in the order indicated in the draw. No substitution of players and changes of starting times shall be permitted after the draw has been made.
- 2. The OC reserves the rights to fix and/or alter the starting times.

9. SUBMISSION OF SCORECARD

Players should check their card in the scoring area and correct and duly sign it. Any doubtful points should be settled with the Committee before returning the scorecard.

10. DECISION OF TIES

Individual Event

- 1. In the event of a tie or ties for the first place, the champion shall be decided by a hole by hole play-off to take place as soon as practicable. The purpose of the play-off is to decide the Champion only. In the event inclement weather or other reason to make the play-off impractical, the Organizing Committee's decision to determine the Champion is final.
- 2. All other ties will be decided on the lowest score for the last 18 hole (or the last 9 or 6 or 3 or 1 holes). If tie still arises, the score for the 2nd round and, if necessary, the 1st round will be treated in the same way until a decision is reached.

Team Event

In the event of a tie on all placing, the score of the team will be used to break the tie. Lowest team score for the last round. If tie still arises, the team's score of the preceding round until a decision is reached.





11. <u>INCLEMENT WEATHER</u>

- 1. In the event that the first round of The Championship cannot be completed, it shall be continued on the next day prior to the commencement of the second round.
- 2. In the event that the second round of the Championship cannot be completed, it shall be continued on the next day prior to the commencement of the third round.
- 3. In the event that the second and/or third round of the Championship cannot be completed, the rounds shall be abandoned. The result of the Championship will then be based on the completed rounds.

12. CADDIES

- 1. The use of caddies is allowed for this Championship and players are only allowed to use the "in house" caddies and no parents or official are allowed to caddy the player.
- 2. Players shall walk at all times and are not allowed to use any motorized vehicle during the stipulated round unless allowed by the Rules Officials.

13. PACE OF PLAY

Rule 5.6 (Unreasonable Delay; Prompt Pace of Play) will be strictly enforced. See separate Notice to Players for the Pace of Play guidelines.

14. DISPUTES OR DOUBT AS TO PROCEDURE

- 1. If there is a doubt as to the correct procedures, players are to refer to the Tournament Rules Official. If a Tournament Rules Official is not immediately available, a player (having notified his marker) may elect to play two balls in accordance with Rule 20.1c(3) and obtain a ruling at the conclusion of the round, prior to signing and the return of the scorecard.
- 2. No spectators (including parents or accompanying officials) are to enter into any discussion on a matter under dispute.

15. TOURNAMENT RULES OFFICIAL/REFEREE

The Tournament Rules Official/Referee's decision on all matters pertaining to the Rules of Golf is Final.

16. INSURANCE

It is assumed by the Committee that all players have appropriate golfing insurance.





17. PRIZES

The Following prizes will be awarded:

Individual Event

- 1. Boys & Girls Champion;
- 2. Boys group 5 best gross winner; Girls Group 3 best gross winner.

Note: The Champions are not eligible for the Age Group Best Gross Winner

Team Event

Boys & Girls Team Champion and Runner Up

18. PRACTICE

- 1. Official practice is provided on 15th December 2025. For tee time, please report to the club's starter. Practice should be finished by 14:00 hours.
- 2. No multiple ball play shall be allowed during the official practice round.
- 3. Players are not allowed to practice on the course after their round on any day of the Championship.
- 4. The driving range will be opened at 05:30 hours during the Championship.
- 5. Range balls are chargeable at IDR 90.000 per 50 balls for players who wish to use the driving range facility after each round.

19. WELCOME RECEPTION

All players are invited to Opening & Welcome Reception on 15th December 2025 at the Pondok Indah Golf Course.

20. PRIZE PRESENTATION

All players are invited to a Prize Presentation Luncheon on 18th December 2025 at the Pondok Indah Golf Course.

21. DRESS CODE

1. Players must be properly attired on the golf course. Blue jeans, designer jeans, round neck T-shirt and tank tops are prohibited.





- 2. This dress code will be used in conjunction with any additional dress code restrictions of the host club. A player violating this dress code will not be permitted to start the tournament. A violation of this dress code by player during the stipulated round must be rectified without undue delay or the player will not be allowed to continue play. Rules pertaining to this matter is expressed in Point 49.
- 3. Soft spikes shoes are compulsory.

22. CONDUCT OF PLAYERS

All players should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship at all times, irrespective of how competitive they may be. Rule 1.2b and Committee Procedures Section 5H are in effect. Separate Code of Conduct Policy is available.

23. SPECTATORS/ ACCOMPANYING OFFICIALS/PARENTS

- 1. Spectators/accompanying official/parents must remain on the cart paths at all times. They must stay off the greens and out of the bunkers at all times. They are prohibited from using golf buggies.
- 2. They should maintain a reasonable distance from the players to avoid the appearance that they are imparting advice or assisting the player in any way. They may approach a player for a moment to exchange clothing, food or beverage, but should not have prolonged contact.
- 3. Those found violating these policies may be asked to leave the course.
